- Relating to, or making use of several disciplines at once.

Cross-disciplinary

- Coordinated effort involving two or more academic disciplines.

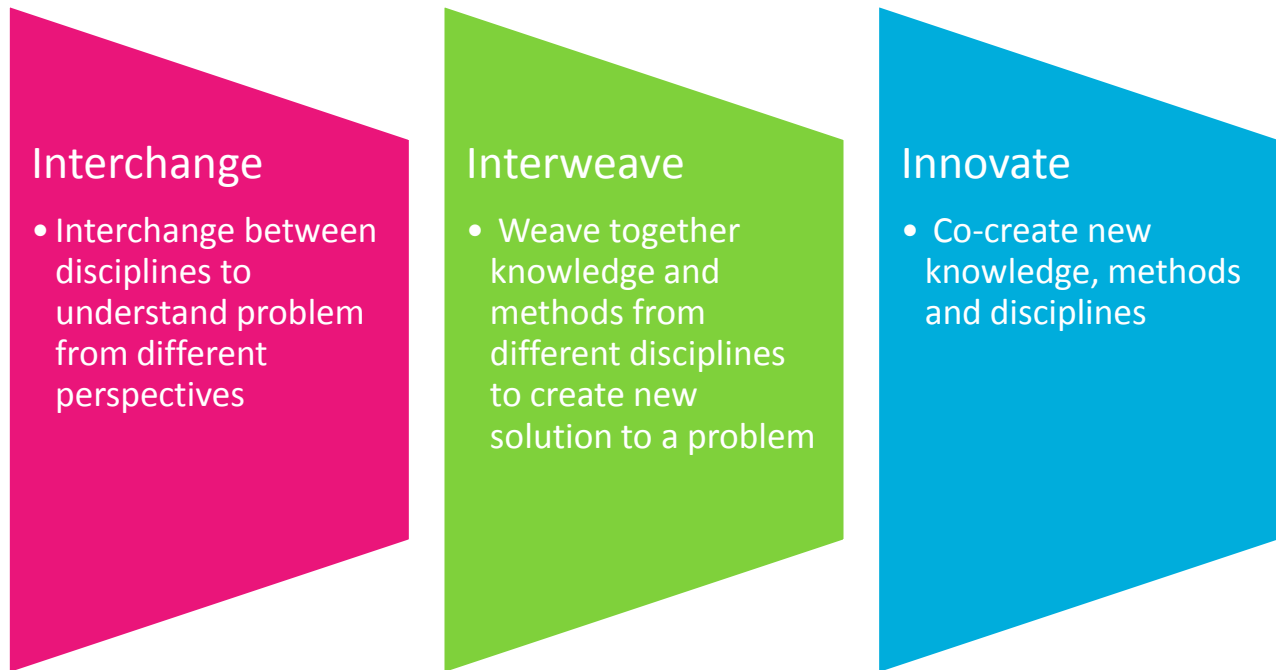
Transdisciplinary

- Approaches that transcend boundaries of conventional disciplines.

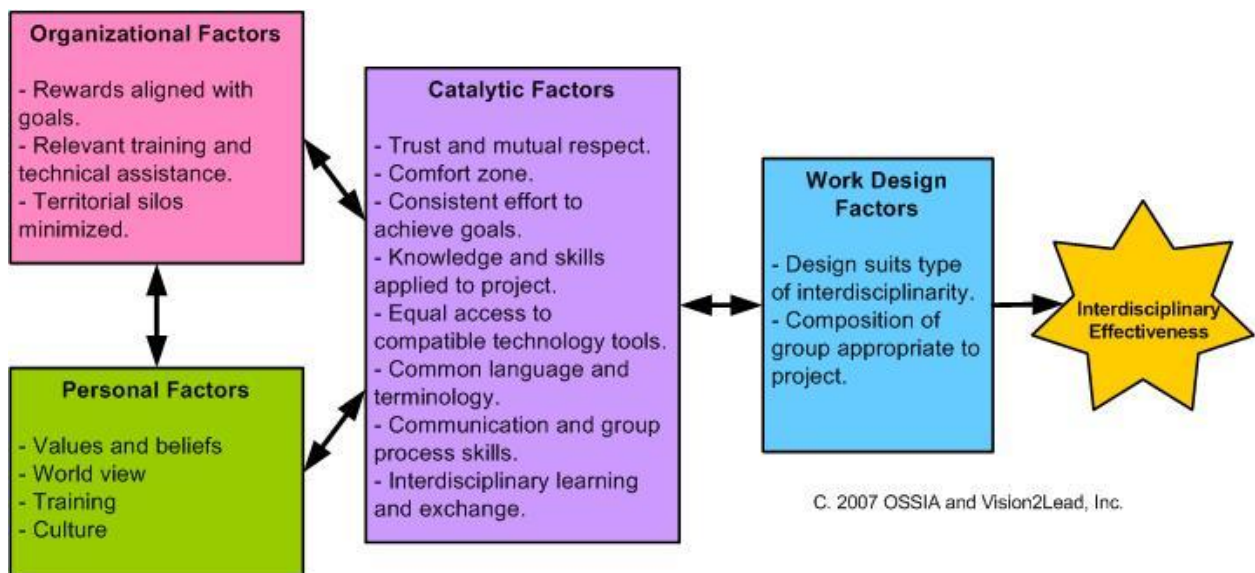
Interdisciplinary
